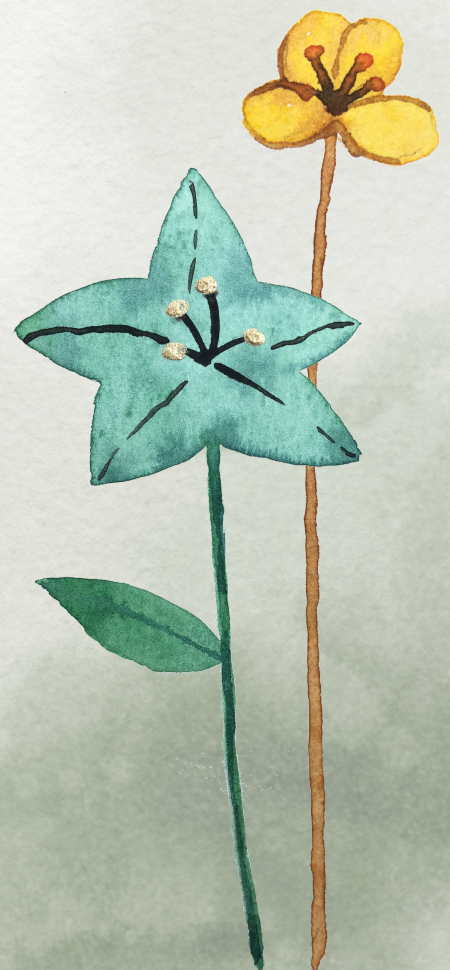

Contest Rules & Guidelines | 2024 Poster Design Contest

Contest Rules and Guidelines:

- All 6th - 12th-grade students are invited to participate.
- There is no fee.
- One entry per student.
- All entries must be original student works.
- Required poster size is 11 tall wide by 8.5 inches wide.
- All entries must have a complete and legible entry form attached to the back of the poster (please tape the form to the back - no staples).
- Student's name should NOT appear on the front of the poster.
- Students may enter electronic art by emailing the Ferry Conservation District office.
- Posters can be created using poster paints, watercolor, colored pencils, pastels, oil, crayons, pencils, charcoal, markers, and original digital art. (Please note: Pastels, pencils, and charcoal should be sprayed with a fixative to prevent smearing.)

THEME:

Conservation & Natural Resources in Ferry County. Examples: composting, pollinators, canning, agriculture, clean streams, soil, planting trees, etc.

Winner Selection Criteria:

1. Poster Relevance/Message (should relate to the theme)
2. Originality (unique, creative design).
3. Clarity (free of spelling and grammatical errors and/or stray marks).
